C programming using Microsoft's C compiler in MS-DOS. We were the first department allowed to have a LAN. It was a coaxial ethernet loop. It crashed a lot. Mentor, John W. Carter, allowed me to spend two weeks trying to perfect dynamic runtime linking like would later be called a Dynamic Link Library .DLL on Windows. I worked from the Common Object Model .obj linking handbook specification by Microsoft. I could get it to work but not make it practical for replacing object code inside machines at hospitals.
